As we enter the second semester we wanted to take a moment to send some reminders to ensure the safety of your children and all the students here at Woodbridge ECEC.

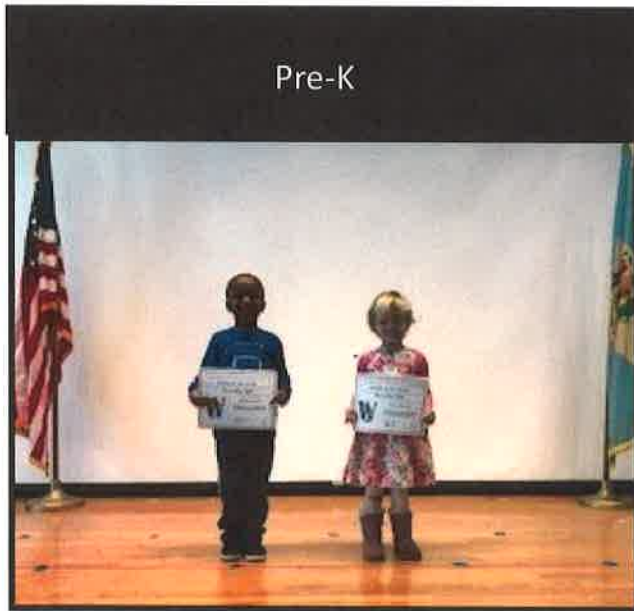
- * First, all visitors must sign in at the front desk and receive a visitor tag before moving past the front doors into the hallways of the school. Those in the halls or classrooms without a visitor tag will be sent back to the front office to sign in and receive a visitor tag. You also must have your license with you in order to sign in. At the end of the month, we will have a school safety officer that will be greeting you and helping to monitor our school.
- * Second, we provide excellent educational opportunities in an older building. As such on colder days, there will be drafts and cooler temperatures in hallways and corridors. Please dress your children in layers so that they can either add or take away throughout their day to be as comfortable as possible.
- * Next, we have a uniform policy here in the Woodbridge School District, and though there are times we may celebrate something, we need to adhere to this policy all of the other times.
- * Doors will continue to open at 8:20 for parent drop off and buses begin to unload at 8:30.
- * Parent pick up will continue to start at 3:40 at the Ewing Entrance. No student will be released to a caregiver after 3:30 through the front office. Dismissal is a busy time for the whole building and we need to ensure we have dismissed all students safely.
- * Please update your emergency information with the front office if changes have been made since the start of school. This includes phone numbers, emergency contacts and any transportation information.
- * If your child has required a change of uniform clothing for any reason and they required the change to come from the school closet or nurses office, please return the clothing. There are many times we run out of clothing due to a shortage because items are not returned. We are at that point right now.
- * Kindergarten registration is coming up in March and April. Please look for information pertaining to dates and times for our in-house registration and screening process.

The upcoming months can be so unpredictable when it comes to weather. Snow, cold, rain, wind, ice, and probably some warm days mixed in are the usual for this time of year. It is important that our students have good school attendance. We have high expectations for our students and we need them to be here so our teachers can teach and our students can learn!

****Registration and screening will be completed at the same time during the appointment****

REQUIREMENTS TO ENROLL – please bring the following items to your appointment:

- Must be five years of age or older on or before August 31, 2020.
- Child's **official birth certificate** & social security number.
- Copy of the child's most current physical exam; blood lead testing date & results; Tuberculosis (Mantoux) testing date & results or TB Risk Assessment
- Immunization record
- Proof of residency in the Woodbridge School District (examples: lease agreement, mortgage document, property tax receipt, current month's electric, phone or gas bill with the 911 address and name of the parent/guardian of the child being registered)
- Parent's/Guardian's Photo ID
- Custody/Guardian papers (if applicable)

Beginning March 2nd, registration packets may be picked up prior to scheduled registration dates. **It is necessary to bring the child with you at this time. Student screening will be completed during registration.**
