Positive Parent Tip: Redirect, redirect, redirect. Children who hear "No" or "Don't" all the time tend to tune those directives out. So instead of telling your child what *not* to do, offer a positive behavior to replace the misbehavior. Frequently at school you will hear us refer to "Walking Feet" instead of saying "No running." Another example is when we compliment students who are "Showing the quiet signal" or who are "Making good hand choices with their hands to themselves." Other students will make note of this and change to follow suit.



****Registration and screening will be completed at the same time during the appointment****

REQUIREMENTS TO ENROLL -- please bring the following items to your appointment:

- Must be five years of age or older on or before August 31, 2019.
- Child's **official birth certificate** & social security number.
- Copy of the child's most current physical exam; blood lead testing date & results; Tuberculosis (Mantoux) testing date & results or TB Risk Assessment
- Immunization record
- Proof of residency in the Woodbridge School District (examples: lease agreement, mortgage document, property tax receipt, **current** month's electric, phone or gas bill with the 911 address and name of the parent/guardian of the child being registered)
- Parent's/Guardian's Photo ID
- Custody/Guardian papers (if applicable)

Beginning March 1st, registration packets may be picked up prior to scheduled registration dates.

It is necessary to bring the child with you at this time. Student screening will be completed during registration.

REQUISITOS PARA INSCRIBIRSE-- por favor traiga los siguientes documentos para su cita:

- Debe cumplir cinco o más años de edad en o antes del 31 de agosto de 2018.
- **Acto de nacimiento oficial del niño** y número de la seguridad social.
- Copia de la examen físico más reciente del niño/a; fecha de prueba de plomo en la sangre y resultados; fecha de prueba de tuberculosis (Mantoux) y los resultados o evaluación de riesgo de tuberculosis
- Record de las vacunas
- Una prueba de residencia en el Woodbridge School District (Ejemplos: contrato de arrendamiento, documento de hipoteca, impuestos a la propiedad, el recibo del mes corriente de eléctrica, teléfono o factura de gas con la dirección 911 y nombre del padre/madre/tutor del niño/a está registrado)
- Identificación con foto del padre/madre/tutor/guardián
- Papeles Oficiales de la Custodia (si corresponde)

Comenzando el 1º de marzo, se puede recoger paquetes de la inscripción antes de la hora prevista para fechas de inscripción. **Es necesario traer al niño/a con usted en este momento, como la evaluación de estudiante se completará durante el registro.**
