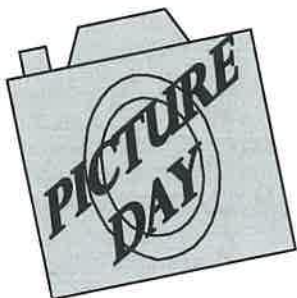

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### Nurse's Notes

With the cold weather brings runny noses, coughs and sore throats; to ensure your child's health please make sure they get plenty of rest and plenty of water. If your child has a temperature over 100.2 your child should stay home. If they develop a temperature in school they will be sent home. Students should not return to school until they are fever free (without help from medications) for 24 hours to ensure another student does not contract the same cold, virus or illness. Any medication you need your student to take needs to be sent in to the nurse. Parents will need to sign a special form giving permission to administer any medicine such as antibiotic or over the counter medicine here at school.

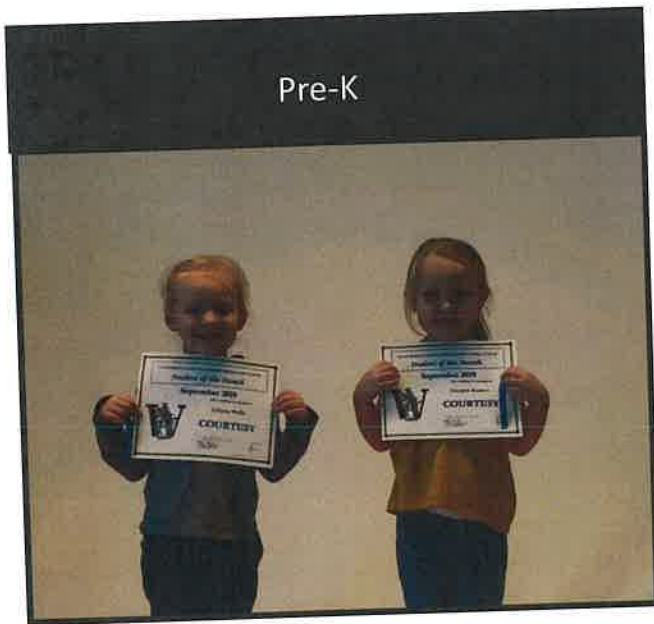
Vision and hearing screenings are complete. Letters have been sent home for students that need further evaluations. If you received a letter please have your child seen by a specialist. We will have access to the Vision to Learn van, which is an eye doctor exam and they will provided glasses if needed. These consent forms were sent home with the referral letter. Please sign and return to the school nurse. Be on the lookout for a date when the van is scheduled to come.

Please make sure the phone numbers the school has on file are correct. If you student becomes ill and needs to be sent home, we need to have accurate contact information.

**NURSE NEEDS YOUR HELP!** If your student has had bathroom accidents this year and clothes (shirts, pants, underwear, socks) have been supplied, please wash them and return them to the nurse as soon as possible. I am running out of smaller size pants (especially boys) and will not be able to supply students if I do not receive these back. Returning these clothes will prevent phones calls in the middle of the day for a parent or guardian to bring in clothes. All kindergarten students should have a set of clothes in their book bag at all times to help with this. Thank you.
